And Whereas, the matter is placed on SRC in its 385th meeting held on 03rd March 2020 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

And Whereas, as per directed a Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution for B.Ed. course on dt. 11.03.2020.

And Whereas, a Final Show Cause Notice reply was received from the institution on dt. 10.09.2020.

And Whereas, the compliance submitted by the institution on dt. 10.09.2020 and the matter was considered by the SRC in its 388th Meeting held on 14th & 15th September 2020 as under:

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution vide letter dt. 10.09.2020, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Paulsons Teacher Training College, Villupuram District, Tamilnadu-605109 for B.Ed programme for 2 basic unit (50 students each unit)."

Now therefore, the SRC decided to permit the institution i.e. Paulsons Teacher Training College, Paulsons Nagar, Pullichapallam, Vanur Taluk, Villupuram District, Tamilnadu-605109 for B.Ed. course run by M/S Pauls Educational Trust, Tamilnadu for continuation of recognition for B.Ed. course of two-years duration with an intake of 100 students (two units) subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:
